Talk to your boss  
Luckily you have a standing weekly meeting with your boss. You know that you will only have time to ask one question because you have a lot of other things to cover. Which question will get you the most information so that you can find the sneezer:  
What is the office policy on coming to work ill?  
How have you been feeling recently?  
Did you hear anyone sneezing earlier?



Talk to co-worker Carrie  
Luckily you and Carrie have a meeting together in an hour and it requires a 7 minute walk. You will have time to ask only one question. Which question will get you the most information so that you can find the sneezer:  
Have you noticed anyone sneezing recently?  
How have you been feeling recently?  
I am searching for a sick person in the office. Would you help me find them?



Go to the Cafeteria  
You are hungry and go to grab a snack. Unfortunately, this does not gain any additional knowledge about the sneezer and you lose 1 hour of time.  
[TRY AGAIN]

Search online  
You decide to look online at your coworkers FaceBook pages to see if you can find anyone posting about not feeling well. Unfortunately, you spend too much time distracted by cute kitty videos and gain no additional knowledge about the sneezer. You lose 1 hour of time.  
[TRY AGAIN]

Talk to your boss: What is the office policy on coming to work ill?  
Your boss states that there is currently no policy on coming to work ill, but does remind you that people have 14 sick days and should take them when needed.  
You have gained a little bit more information about WHY someone MAY come to work ill, but have not gained additional knowledge on WHO is at work sick.  
[TRY AGAIN]

Talk to your boss: How have you been feeling recently?  
Your boss says that he is feeling great after running a half marathon over the weekend, but is slightly concerned that he may catch something from a meeting he was in yesterday. Before you can ask further questions he gets a call and says he has to take it.  
You now know that your boss is most likely NOT the sneezer and the sneezer was in a meeting with him yesterday.  
What next:  
Look at his calendar to see who was in the meeting with him yesterday?  
Wait until his call is over to ask him more questions?

Talk to your boss: Did you hear anyone sneezing earlier?  
Your boss says that he has been in meetings most of the morning but did hear some sneezing while getting a morning cup of coffee.  
You now know that the sneezer's cubicle is most likely near the break room.  
You should probably talk to your co-worker Carrie now to see if she can provide more info.

Look at yesterday's calendar:  
You see that your boss was in a meeting with three of your co-workers: Carrie, Shina, and Demetri. You and Carrie are in meetings together so you decide to talk to her.  
You know now that it could be one of three people.

Wait until his call is over to ask him more questions:  
Unfortunately, the call was from DayCare and he has to run to pick up a sick child.  
You have gained no additional knowledge and wasted more time.  
[TRY AGAIN]

Talk to co-worker Carrie: Have you noticed anyone sneezing recently?  
Carrie says that when she is at her desk she is typically on the phone and doesn't hear too well, but she thinks that she heard a sneeze from near the break room this morning.  
You now know that the sneezer's cubicle is most likely near the break room.  
You still have a few minutes and casually ask how Carrie has been feeling recently?

Talk to co-worker Carrie: How have you been feeling recently?  
Your co-worker says that she was feeling ok, but thinks she may have picked up something from a meeting yesterday with your boss and two other colleagues. She doesn't have time to tell you who was in the meeting because you arrive at the meeting room.  
You now know that your co-worker is most likely NOT the sneezer and that the culprit was most likely in the meeting yesterday.  
Ask who was in the meeting on the walk back to your cubicle?  
Check the calendar to see who was in the meeting with Carrie?  
Assume Carrie is the sneezer?

Ask who was in the meeting on the walk back to your cubicle?  
You wait until the end of the meeting and ask Carrie who was in the meeting. She tells you that it was your boss, Shina and Demetri.  
You know now who was in the meeting.  
Talk to Shina?  
Talk to Demetri?  
Determine which cubicle Shina and Demetri are in?

Check the calendar to see who was in the meeting with Carrie?  
While others are setting up for the meeting you check yesterday's calendar to see who was in the meeting.  
You know now who was in the meeting: Carrie, your boss, Shina, and Demetri.  
Talk to Shina?  
Talk to Demetri?  
Determine which cubicle Shina and Demetri are in?

Carrie is not the sneezer. It is not a good idea to make assumptions. You do not have enough information to come to a conclusion.  
You have gained no additional knowledge.  
Everyone in the office is now sick.  
[Start Over]
